

## Okefenokee Swamp Park's Science Scholar Annual Scholarship

The Okefenokee Swamp Park, Inc. (OSP) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to showcasing and conserving the wildlife and vast wilderness, waterways, habitats, and rich cultural history of the Okefenokee Swamp. The organization's mission is to provide visitor access and interpretive education that inspires conservation advocacy for the Okefenokee Swamp. Our organization is also dedicated to influencing growth in science-related fields in the Okefenokee RESA area school districts (Atkinson, Bacon, Brantley, Camden, Charlton, Clinch, Coffee, Pierce, and Ware).

The OSP has created this scholarship to recognize and reward an OK RESA district high school senior who, in addition to having a strong desire to communicate with others about the importance of science, research, science education and/or science advocacy, has been accepted to a post-secondary institution and is planning on majoring in one of the sciences (Biological, Physical, or Science Education). Preference will be given to those applicants who provide evidence of a profound bond to the ecosystems in the Okefenokee RESA district, including, but not limited, to the Okefenokee Swamp.

The Okefenokee Swamp Park's Science Scholar will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship in the spring of their senior year and a Lifetime Pass for entrance into the Okefenokee Swamp Park. Upon his/her graduation with a degree in Biological or Physical Sciences, or Science Education, the OSP Science Scholar will also receive a "congratulatory" \$500 stipend.
